What is Brackish Water?

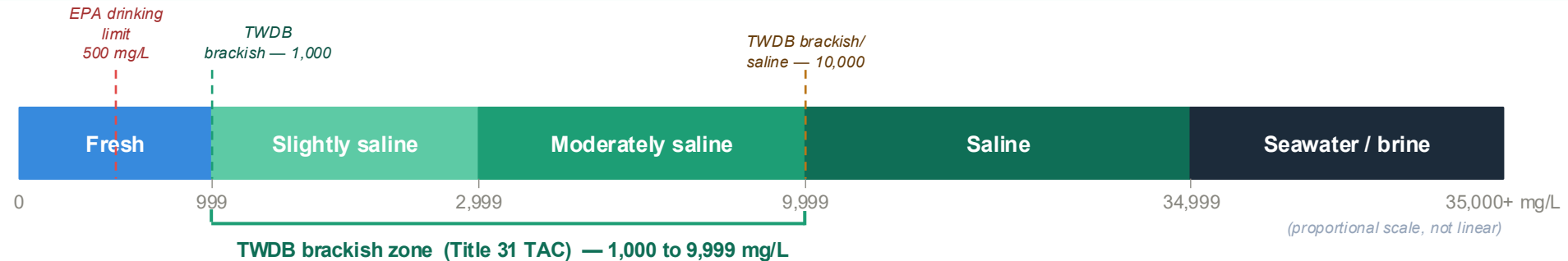
TWDB

Texas Water Development Board

>1,000 to ≤10,000

mg/L TDS (statutory definition)

Texas Water Code §16.060 and TWDB defines brackish groundwater as water with dissolved solids of more than 1,000 mg/L but not more than 10,000 mg/L. HB 30 (84th Legislature, 2015) directed TWDB to produce a Brackish Groundwater Pumping Zone Atlas identifying reserves statewide — including Calhoun County — as alternatives to freshwater aquifers.

TWDB / USGS threshold for potable groundwater. Drinking water, irrigation, and livestock use all appropriate.	Lower end of the TWDB brackish zone. Noticeably salty taste. Unsuitable for drinking without treatment. Lower desalination energy cost — priority target in the BRACS program.	Upper end of TWDB brackish zone. Requires heavy on-site heavy reverse osmosis treatment with high energy costs.	Above TWDB brackish ceiling of 9,999 mg/L — classified as saline, not brackish, under TWC §16.060. Even higher desalination energy cost.	Gulf of Mexico averages ~35,000 mg/L. Brine exceeds this. Dangerous to consume. Very energy-intensive desalination required.

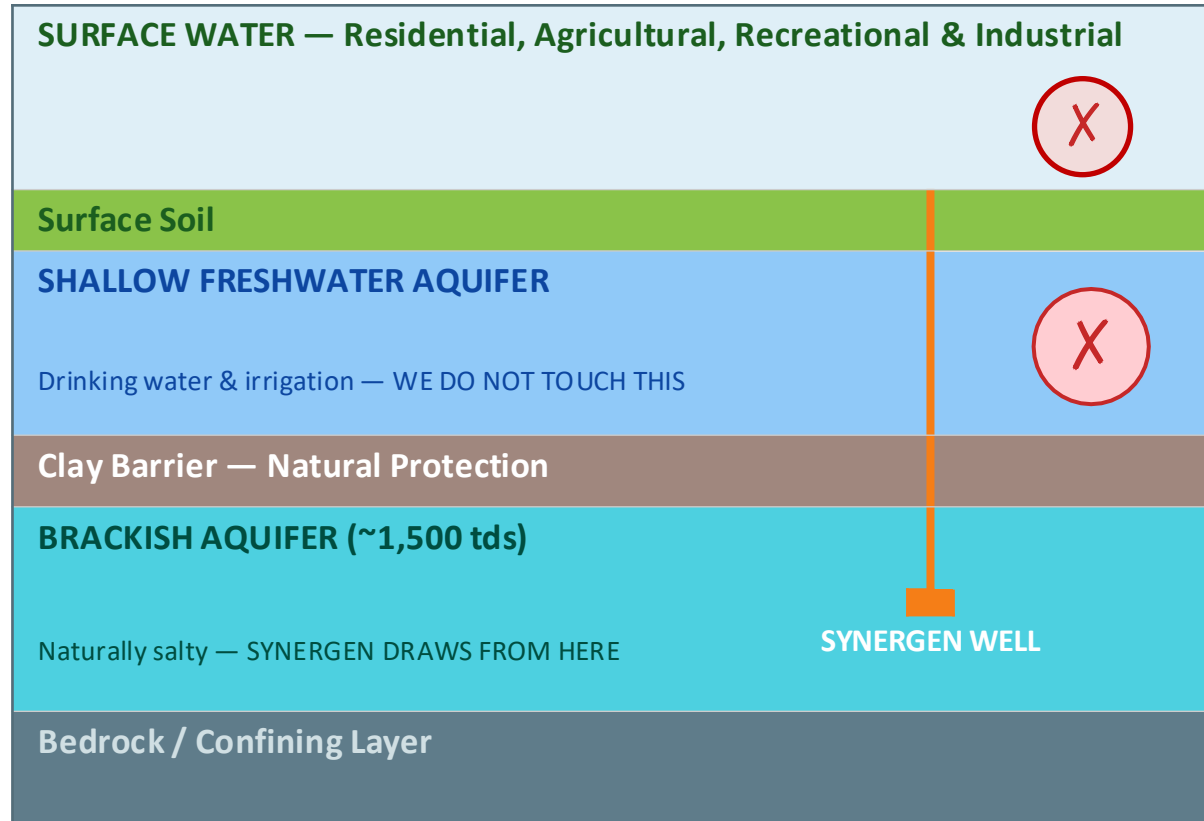
How Our Water Strategy Protects the Water Resource



OUR DELIBERATE CHOICE:

Brackish groundwater ONLY — naturally salty, non-potable, not suitable for drinking or farming. Zero competition with community fresh and surface water supplies.

Brackish Aquifer — Geologically Isolated



Why Brackish? Comparing Water Sources

✗ FRESH GROUNDWATER

NOT our choice

- Residents drink it
- Used for crops & livestock
- Competes with community
- Shared resource under stress
- Would reduce local supply
- Raises community concerns

✓ BRACKISH GROUNDWATER

OUR CHOICE — High TDS, salty, separate

- Naturally salty — undrinkable
- Unfit for crops or livestock
- Isolated from freshwater zones
- Verified by Intera & Geosyntec
- No impact on community supply
- Protects Calhoun County fresh water

Synergen continues to work with GCD to comply and abide by all regulations. Monitoring wells will collect data throughout the life of the project in compliance with the GCD rules. Data will be reported to the GCD and be available to the public.

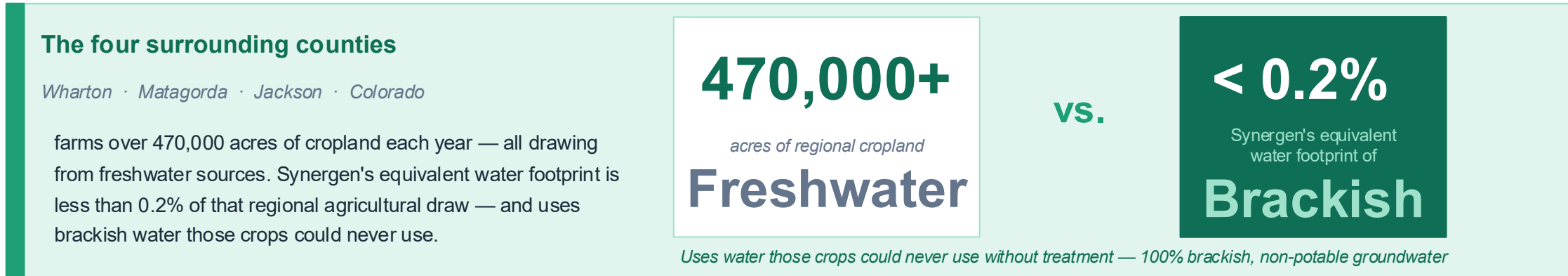
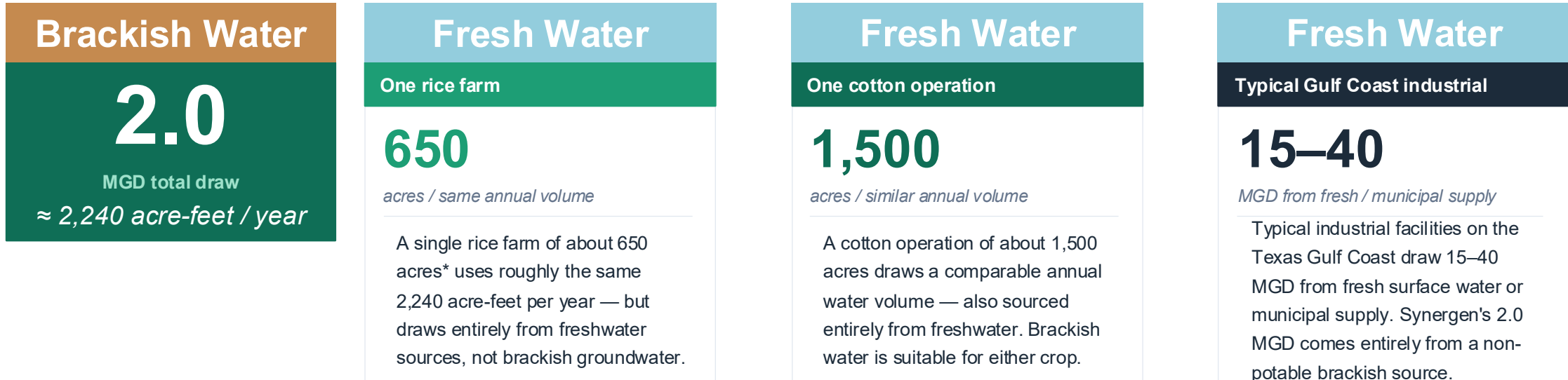

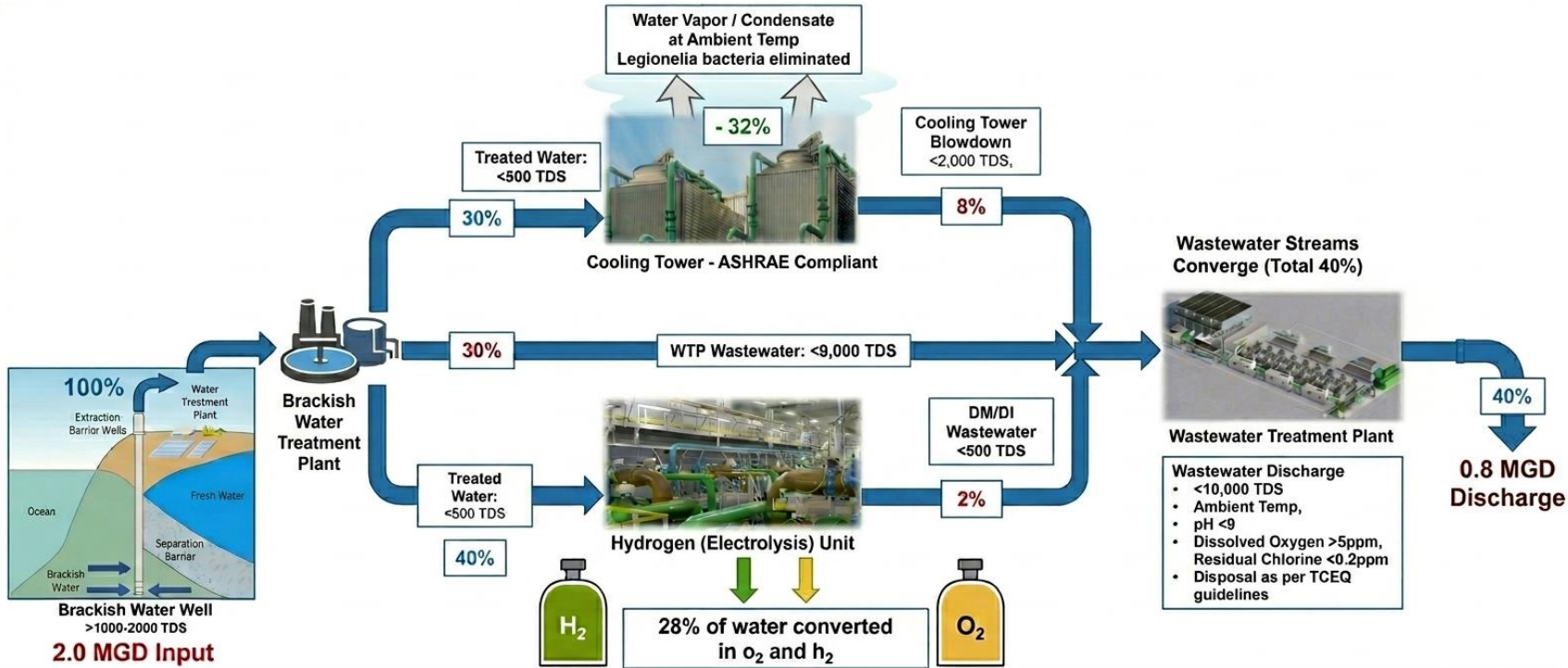
Putting 2.0 MGD Brackish Water in Perspective



All comparisons based on 2,240 acre-feet / year (2.0 MGD continuous draw)

* Assuming dual-crop per year with ratoon crop requiring additional 1 to 1.5 acre feet above the main cotton crop requirement of 1.5-2.5 acre feet
